

I AM A GODLY WOMAN

I am a rare find. I am frugal, diligent and I operate in wisdom both at home and in business. Strength and honor are my clothing and my mouth is full of wisdom. My tongue is full of kindness. I know that beauty is beyond the physical, it is my fear of God that is truly beautiful. (Prov 31) I am made in God's image, in His likeness and character (Gen 1:26). I am careful who I associate with because my delight is in the Word which I meditate and choose to think in line with. Everything I do prospers because of it (Ps 1:1-3). God orders my steps because I have made the Lord my trust (Ps 37:23, Ps 40:4).

(Phil 4:12- I know how to live on almost nothing or with everything. I have learned the secret of living in every situation, whether it is with a full stomach or empty, with plenty or little. For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength. I build my home wisely and I will do nothing to tear it down by word or action. (Prov 14)

(Ps 119:105) God's word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path. (Ps 5:11-12) I put my trust in you. You are my defender. You fill me with your happiness, for you bless the godly, O Lord; you protect me with your shield of love. (Ps 146:5-) I am happy because I have the Lord as my helper and my hope is in my God.
